"Persons suffering from addiction make no sense to those of us who have not suffered with this disease. Why would anyone choose to shoot-up with heroin and risk death, prison or follow on diseases instead of being a productive member of society?" states Rev. Barry Steiner Ball.

Rev. Steiner Ball will be preaching at the New Martinsville United Methodist Church on Sunday, March 22, 2020, at the 9:00 AM and 10:45 AM services. He will present a program at 2:00 PM for the public on understanding how the brain allows opioids to take over a person's life.

Rev. Steiner Ball has a background in Christianity as well as law enforcement: B.A. in Psychology, Master of Divinity from Duke University and Doctor of Ministry from Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, DC, serving many churches in the Maryland area. He served as Chaplain in the U.S. Airforce; attended the Drug Enforcement Administration Academy, Quantico, VA; Maryland Natural Resources Officer; Task Force Officer with Drug Enforcement Administration.

He has received many Awards and commendations from working with the Natural Resources Police; most recently the U.S. Attorney for Northern District of West Virginia's Award for Outstanding Prescription Drug Investigation.
